Drama provides a highly valuable outlet for selfexpression, skill development, and emotional wellbeing within the disability support community.

Drama encourages participants to explore their creativity, build confidence, and improve communication and social interaction in a fun and supportive environment. Through group collaboration, role-play, and storytelling, individuals enhance their teamwork and problem-solving skills while processing emotions in a safe and engaging way.

This program is built around the values of inclusion by focusing on ability rather than limitation, empowering participants to be **seen**, **heard**, and **celebrated**.

Music therapy is a powerful tool - it helps individuals express themselves, connect with others, and build skills in a fun, engaging way.

It can improve communication, boost mood and reduce feelings of anxiety, and support physical movement and coordination all while having **FUN!**

For people with disabilities, music therapy creates a safe and creative space to grow confidence, develop social connections, help reinforce learning (routines, names and sequences) through rhythm and repetition, and achieve personal goals—whether that's learning to take turns, strengthening motor skills, or simply feeling heard and understood. It's therapy that doesn't feel like therapy.

Zumba combines physical movement, music, and social interaction in a fun and inclusive way. It promotes physical health by improving cardiovascular fitness, coordination, and flexibility, while also supporting mental wellbeing through mood-boosting music and movement.

Zumba can be adapted to suit all abilities, making it accessible and empowering to all participants. It fosters a sense of community, connection, and confidence, helping individuals feel more **engaged**, **motivated**, and **supported**.

No Boundaries Zumba routines are modified to suit all our participants physical and cognitive abilities. Whether participants are in wheelchairs, have limited mobility, or sensory sensitivities, our Zumba instructor tailor movements to ensure everyone can join in safely and comfortably.

HOIST - AIDACARE

We recently had to dispose of one of our hoists as it had aged and the parts are no longer available for repair. The hoist is used many times per day to safely assist staff to move participants from their wheelchairs to change bed or into a fallout chair for the day.

EST COST - \$4,161

LOUNGE CHAIRS X 4

Lounge chairs around the centre provide a place for our guys to relax either in a group or by themselves. Brings a sense of home and comfort.

EST COST - \$4,000

Sensory mats which are stain resistant, portable and easy to clean. Provides a soft, sensory feedback for participants to move freely around the floor.

EST COST - \$820

PARTICIPANT ACTIVITY PACK

Outdoor Pool Table

Playing pool can boost concentration levels and provide a great opportunity for our participants to socialise. It can improve hand eye coordination and help participants relax and de-stress.

Air Hockey Table

Playing air hockey can boost concentration levels and provide opportunities for our participants to compete and socialise. It can improve hand eye coordination and help participants to relax and destress. EST COST - \$2,210

CHANGE BEDS

Our current change beds have been onsite for over 10 years. An upgrade will provide a more comfortable mattress, with a quicker and more efficient lift feature.

EST COST - \$7,940

WASHING MACHINE + DISHWASHER

Our current washing machine is ready to be replaced as it leaks from time to time and the warranty has lapsed. The onsite washing machine helps to clean our linen used, and any of the participant's clothing that may require washing while attending for the day.

Our dishwasher (purchased in 2019) requires regular maintenance, a new model would be more efficient for water and power use.

EST COST - \$4,600

SUPPORT OUR SENSORY UNIT!

TOBII EYE GAZE SYSTEM

The new eye gaze model allows for connection to the latest eye gaze technology, further increasing accessibility. Our communication initiative can be expanded to include more participants to utilise this technology. The eye gaze system we currently have is 8 years old.

MAGIC CARPET - SENSORY UNIT

Our current projector unit (purchased in 2016) is becoming too old to cope with the newer technology offered. The image quality is decreasing and needs constant rebooting. The Magic Mirror which projects onto the floor for participants to interact with, is our most used device in the Sensory Unit.
